

RESOLUTION 82-5


WHEREAS, the week of May 16 through 22, 1982, has been proclaimed National Transportation Week;

WHEREAS, public transit is recognized as a fundamental public service and is a vital component of the nation's transportation infrastructure;


WHEREAS, public transit service translates into productive jobs for the nation's workers, mobility and commerce, and broad support for business and economic growth;
