

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS
RESOLUTION NO. 82-7

Sections 1,2,3,4,5 of Resolution 82-6, adopted on July 14,1982 currently read as follows:

Section 1: Purchases by Department heads, to established vendors , to the sum of \$50.00 (fifty dollars) without prior approval, providing such funds do exist.

Section 2: Purchases by the Mayor at the request of department Heads, to established vendors, shall not exceed \$100.00 (one hundred dollars). Prior Council approval is not required providing such funds exist.

Section 3: Purchases in the sum in excess of \$100.00(one hundred dollars) must have prior approval of the majority of the Town Council as decided at a regular Council Meeting.

Section 4: In the event of a real emergency, the previous sections shall be superceded and the guidelines of RCW 35.33.081 and RCW 35.33.091 shall prevail.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in effect from the date of passage until December 31, 1982, at which time it will be reviewed.

These sections are repealed and not to be given further force or effect;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON; Resolution 82-6 is hereby amended to here and after read as follows:

Section 1: Purchases by Department Heads, to established vendors, to the sum of \$50.00(fifty dollars) with approval of the majority of the Council, providing such funds do exist.

Section 2: All purchasing or expending of any Town of Granite Falls funds by the Mayor are hereby eliminated.

Section 3: Purchases in the sum in excess of \$50.00(fifty dollars) must have prior approval of the majority of the Town Council as decided at a regular Council Meeting.

Section 4: In the event of a real emergency, the previous sections shall be superceded and the guidelines of RCW 35.33.081 and RCW 35.33.091 shall prevail with the majority of the Council's approval

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in effect from the date of passage until December 8, 1982, at which time it will be reviewed.

This Resolution adopted this 28th day of July 1982.
