

RESOLUTION 82-11

RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION

BETWEEN

GRANITE FALLS AND SNOHOMISH COUNTY

This resolution made as of this 10th day of November, 1982, between GRANITE FALLS and SNOHOMISH COUNTY to adopt the Snohomish County Solid Waste Management Study:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management-Recovery and Recycling Act, contained in Chapter 70.95 RCW, requires all cities and all counties in Washington to prepare and periodically update comprehensive solid waste management plans, and;

WHEREAS, GRANITE FALLS has authority to collect and dispose of solid waste, per Chapter 35.92 RCW, and;

WHEREAS, SNOHOMISH COUNTY has authority to provide for disposal of solid waste, per Chapter 36.58 RCW, and;

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, contained in Chapter 39.34 RCW, permits any one or more public agencies to jointly perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which each public agency entering into the agreement is authorized by law to perform, and;

WHEREAS, GRANITE FALLS and SNOHOMISH COUNTY may jointly prepare one Solid Waste Management Plan, per Chapter 70.95.080 RCW to satisfy the planning requirements of both jurisdictions, and;

WHEREAS, the public health, welfare and safety of the residents of both GRANITE FALLS and SNOHOMISH COUNTY require the safe and efficient disposal of solid waste, and;

WHEREAS, the final disposal of solid waste from GRANITE FALLS can be done efficiently within the Snohomish County solid waste management system of existing or planned facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, GRANITE FALLS does hereby agree to jointly adopt with SNOHOMISH COUNTY by Resolution No. 82-11 the Snohomish County Solid Waste Management Study.

This Resolution adopted this 10 day of November, 1982.
