RESOLUTION NO. 83-4

WHEREAS, during the past year the Town Council has been petitioned by the Granite Falls Library Board to submit to the voters of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, on November 8, 1983, a request to approve a special levy of Six-thousand - five hundred dollars (\$6500.00) in excess property tax (approximately \$.35 per \$1000.00 assessed value based on 100% true and fair value), for maintenance and operation of the Granite Falls Library in 1984.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of The Town of Granite Falls, Washington, that the Town of Granite Falls will submit to the voters of Granite Falls on November 8, 1983, a request to approve a special levy of Six thousand - five hundred dollars (\$6500.00) in excess property tax to pay for Library Service in 1984.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 14 day of September, 1983.
