RESOLUTION NO. 83-5

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE DECOMMISSIONED POLICE CAR AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, one vehicle particularly identified as a green, 1974 Chevrolet, 4 door, 1L69S6J231386, is no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, such vehicle is surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls as follows:

Section 1. 1974 Chevrolet, 4 door, 1L69S6J231386, is declared as surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Said vehicle is to be sold to the highest bidder at the City of Everett Auction, on September 17, 1983.

Section 3. Said vehicle is to be sold "As is" with no warranty either expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose whatsoever.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 14 day of September, 1983.
