RESOLUTION NO. 83-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY OF \$1.00 PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION OVER THE REGULAR TAX LEVY, THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH LEVY TO BE USED FOR THE PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls that it is necessary to maintain an adequate level of fire protection services for the residents of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has previously contracted with Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 17 for the provision of such fire protection services; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has previously allocated funds for such fire protection services from its regular tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 17 proposes to submit to the electors a proposal to authorize the increase of its tax levy to one dollar per thousand dollars of assessed valuation; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls cannot continue to meet the present costs and anticipated future increased costs of fire protection services from its regular tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.55.050, regular property taxes may be levied in excess of the 106% levy limit, upon approval of the qualified voters of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, that there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town for their ratification or rejection, at an election

to be held on November 8, 1983, the question of whether or not a total tax of \$3.357 per thousand of assessed valuation, representing the estimated base tax levy of \$2.357 per thousand plus \$1.00 per thousand, shall be levied for the year 1983, for collection in 1984. That portion of the taxes at the rate of \$1.00 per thousand, collected pursuant to this levy shall be used only for the provision of fire protection services.

The Town Council hereby requests the Auditor of Snohomish County, as ex officio supervisor of elections, to submit the following proposition at such election, in the form of a ballot, titled substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 2

GRANITE FALLS AUTHORIZATION FOR INCREASE IN REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.

SHALL GRANITE FALLS BE AUTHORIZED TO INCREASE ITS REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY TO \$3.357 PER THOUSAND OF ASSESSED VALUE FOR THE YEAR 1983, FOR COLLECTION IN 1984, THE INCREASE OF \$1.00 PER THOUSAND OF ASSESSED VALUE TO BE FOR FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES.
