

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS

RESOLUTION NO. 83-8

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has received a petition for vacation of the Southerly fifteen (15) feet of West Grand Street; and

WHEREAS the Southerly fifteen (15) feet of West Grand Street is more accurately described as follows: That portion of the Southerly 15.00 feet of West Grand Street lying Westerly of the Westerly right-of-way line of Granite Avenue, according to the plat of the Original Townsite of Granite Falls, as per plat recorded in Volume 2 of Plats, page 99, records of Snohomish County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the petition has been signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the part of such street; and

WHEREAS, the petitioners respectfully represent and allege that the road is not necessary as a part of the general road system and the public will not be inconvenienced by its vacation, and that all of the petitioners are freeholders residing in said Snohomish County and are property owners in the vicinity of said road;

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls that a public hearing shall be held on January 11, 1984, at 7:30 P.M., at the Granite Falls Town Hall, Council Chambers, 206 South Granite Avenue, Granite Falls, Washington, to hear said petition.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 14 day of December, 1983.
