RESOLUTION NO. 84-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTION TO WASHINGTON STATE RETIREMENT FOR THE YEAR 1984.

Whereas, the Council of the Town of Granite Falls has approved payment of the employee contribution to the Washington State Retirement Program by the Town of Granite Falls; and

Whereas, the Council of the Town of Granite Falls has agreed to pay employee contribution of retirement that is in effect as of January 1, 1984;

Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls that the employee contribution to the Washington State Retirement for 1984 shall be paid by the Town of Granite Falls as a personnel benefit.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, this personnel benefit paid by the Town of Granite Falls, shall be paid at a rate that is in effect as of January 1, 1984. Any increase in the retirement contribution in the year 1984, due by the employee, shall be the responsibility of the employee.

This Resolution shall be in effect from the date of passage until December 31, 1984, at which time it will be reviewed.

This Resolution adopted this 11th day of January, 1984.
