A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PETITION FOR ANNEXATION SUBMITTED BY ROBERT KING.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has received a petition for annexation submitted by Robert King;

WHEREAS, the petition for annexation is for property in the amount of approximately three and one-half $(3\frac{1}{2})$ acres more accurately described as follows: Beginning at a point 140.25 feet South and 20 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 30 North, Range 6 East, W.M.; thence South 518.5 feet, more or less, to the North line of the property deeded to Robert D. Henderson, under Auditor's File No. 820896; thence West 351.5 feet; thence North 518.5 feet, more or less, to a line drawn parallel with and 140.25 feet south of the North line of said Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; thence East 351.5 feet to the point of beginning; EXCEPT that portion thereof described as follows: Beginning at a point 188.25 feet South and 20 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 13, Township 30 North, Range 6 East W.M.; thence West 150 feet and parallel to the North line; thence South 164 feet and parallel to the East line; thence East 150 feet; thence North 164 feet to the Point of Beginning; ALSO EXCEPT that portion thereof, conveyed to the County of Snohomish, for road purposes, by Deed dated October 5, 1910, recorded under Auditor's File No. 160547. Situate in the County of Snohomish, State of Washington.

WHEREAS, this petition for annexation was reviewed by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls at the regular Council Meeting of January 25, 1984;

NOW, THEREFORE,
