RESOLUTION NO. 84-3

A RESOLUTION SETTING THE PENALTIES FOR PARKING CITATIONS AS ESTABLISHED UNDER TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS ORDINANCE NO. 353.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls that the following penalties shall apply for parking citations issued in the Town of Granite Falls:

Penalties paid within twenty four (24) hours: \$ 3.00

Penalties paid after twenty four (24) hours but within seven days: \$ 5.00

After seven (7) days a citation for the following amount will be issued: \$37.00

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls that said penalties shall be subject to review at the request of the Town Council or the request of the Chief of Police.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and posting according to law.
