RESOLUTION NO. 84-7

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COUNTY LANDFILL
IN THE GRANITE FALLS AREA.

WHEREAS, the road system is already heavily impacted and would be worse with the addition of sanitation trucks moving through the Granite Falls area; and

WHEREAS, the additional impact on the water quality of the surrounding area wells, water table, and local lakes would be in danger; and

WHEREAS, the human life style of people in the area would be disrupted by the addition of animals and odor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, as follows:

The Town of Granite Falls does hereby unanimously disapprove of the development of a County landfill in any area near Granite Falls and we strongly urge Snohomish County to consider other means of disposing of waste.
