RESOLUTION NO. 84-8

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE ONE (1) GALLIAN ROAD GRATER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, one (1) road grater particularly identified as a 1950 Gallian Road Grater, Serial No. 83742, is no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls, and

WHEREAS, such vehicle is surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, as follows:

Section 1. One (1) Gallian Road Grater is declared as surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Said vehicle is to be sold to the highest bidder.

Section 3. Said vehicle is to be sold "As is" with no warranty either expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose whatsoever.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 23 day of May, 1984.
