RESOLUTION NO. 84-9

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE ONE (1) ELGIN MODEL 81 STREET SWEEPER AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, one (1) street sweeper particularly identified as a Elgin Model 81 Street Sweeper, Serial No. 2482 with 3 cubic yard hopper, half cab is no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, such vehicle is surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, as follows:

Section 1. One (1) street sweeper particularly identified as a Elgin Model 81 Street Sweeper, Serial No. 2482 with 3 cubic yard hopper, half cab is declared as surplus property to the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Said vehicle is to be sold to the highest bidder.

Section 3. Said vehicle is to be sold "As is" with no warranty either expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose whatsoever.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 23 day of May, 1984.
