RESOLUTION NO. 84-12

A RESOLUTION TO DECLARE THE DECOMMISSIONED POLICE CAR AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, one vehicle particularly identified as a blue, 1976 Chevrolet Impala, 4 door, IL6956J231002, is no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, such vehicle is surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls as follows:

Section 1. One (1) 1976 Chevrolet Impala, 4 door, IL6956J231002, is declared as surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Said vehicle is to be sold to the highest bidder at the City of Everett Auction, on
