RESOLUTION NO. 85-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS CALLING FOR AN ELECTION REGARDING PROVISION OF POLICE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls is considering contracting with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office for law enforcement services and eliminating its own police department due to the rising costs of maintaining a police department; and

WHEREAS, this action would be of major importance and concern to the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, residents of Granite Falls have expressed concern in having a voice in this matter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

There shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town of Granite Falls, at an election to be held on November 5, 1985, the question of whether or not the Town of Granite Falls should contract with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office for Law Enforcement Services rather than retaining the Town Police Department to provide such services. The Granite Falls Town Council hereby requests the Auditor of Snohomish County, as ex officio supervisor of elections, to submit the following proposition at such election in the form of a ballot titled substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION NO. 2

TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS ADVISORY VOTE REGARDING PROVISION OF POLICE SERVICES.

Shall the Town of Granite Falls contract with the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office for Law Enforcement Services rather than retain the Town Police DEpartment to provide such services? (This shall be an advisory opinion to the Town Council only, and shall not constitute a final decision on the matter.)
