RESOLUTION NO. 86-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS TO DECLARE THE
DECOMMISSIONED POLICE VEHICLE AS SURPLUS PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, one vehicle particularly identified as a 1978 Dodge Monaco,
4 door, WL41U8A193701, is no longer useable by the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, such vehicle is surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of Granite Falls as
follows:

Section 1. One (1) 1978 Dodge Monaco, 4 door, WL41U8A193701, is declared
as surplus equipment to the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2. Said vehicle is to be sold to the highest bidder.

Section 3. Said vehicle is to be sold "As Is" with no warranty either
expressed or implied as to completeness or suitability for any purpose what-
soever.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the
Town of Granite Falls on the 24 day of November, 1986.
