A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS APPOINTING THE CLERK AS THE AUDITING OFFICER FOR THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS.


WHEREAS, RCW 42.24.080, states all claims presented against any Town by persons furnishing materials, rendering services or performing labor, or for any other contractual purpose, shall be audited, before payment, by an auditing officer appointed by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, RCW. 42.24.080, states the auditing officer shall certify that the materials have been furnished, the services rendered and the labor performed as described, and that the claim is a just, due and unpaid obligation against the municipal corporation and no claim shall be paid without such certification; and

WHEREAS, an auditing officer has not been appointed for the Town of Granite Falls;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls hereby appoint the Clerk as the auditing officer for the Town of Granite Falls who shall certify on all claims that the materials have been furnished, the services rendered and the labor performed as described, and that the claim is a just, due and unpaid obligation against the municipal corporation and no claim shall be paid without such certification.
