RESOLUTION NO. 87-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DESIGNATING THE ACCUMULATION IN THE EQUIPMENT FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF BACKHOE AND DESIGNATING A MONTHLY TRANSFER FROM WATER, SEWER AND STREETS FOR THIS PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council is aware of the need of replacement of public works equipment, more specifically a backhoe; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is aware the funding for this purchase will need to be accumulated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of Granite Falls as follows:

Section 1. The Equipment Fund shall be accumulated for the purchase of a backhoe until sufficient funds are available and included in the yearly budget.


Section 2. The monthly transfer to the Equipment fund shall be as follows:

From the Water Fund	\$ <u>100.00</u>
From the Street Fund	\$ <u>100.00</u>
From the Sewer Fund	\$ <u>100.00</u>

Section 3. When sufficient funds are accumulated for the purchase of said backhoe, said purchase shall be made, and this Resolution shall be void.

Said Resolution was passed in open session by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls on the 14 day of October, 1987.
