RESOLUTION NO. 88-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DESIGNATING SNOHOMISH COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 17 AS THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS INCIDENT COMMAND AGENCY TO OPERATE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS.

WHEREAS, Section 4, Chapter 172, laws of 1982, Revised Code of Washington requires that the governing body of the Town of Granite Falls designate a hazardous materials incident command agency within the boundaries of the Town of Granite Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has considered the training, manpower, expertise, and equipment of available agencies and the applicable codes and regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls finds that Snohomish County Fire District No. 17 has the training, manpower, expertise, and equipment available to meet the applicable codes and regulations.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls that Snohomish County Fire District No. 17 is hereby designated as hazardous materials incident command agency to operate within the boundaries of the Town of Granite Falls.
