## RESOLUTION NO. 89-8

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, CALLING FOR AN ELECTION AUTHORIZING AN ADDITIONAL TAX LEVY TO BE MADE EACH YEAR FOR SIX (6) CONSECUTIVE YEARS, COMMENDING IN 1989 FOR COLLECTION IN 1990, IN THE AMOUNT OF 25¢ PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF ASSESSED VALUATION, THE PROCEEDS OF SUCH LEVY TO BE USED FOR THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, it is the judgement of the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls that it is necessary to provide emergency medical services to the residents of the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town has previously contracted with Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 17 for the provision of such emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls has previously allocated funds for such emergency medical services from its regular tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Granite Falls cannot continue to meet the present cost and anticipated future increased costs of emergency medical services from its regular tax revenues; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.52.069, a special levy may be assessed for the purpose of funding emergency medical care and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, that there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town for their ratification or rejection, at an election to be held on November 7, 1989, the question of whether or not a tax of 25¢ per thousand of assessed valuation shall be levied in each year for six (6) consecutive years, commencing with the year 1989, for collection in 1990. All taxes collected pursuant to this levy shall be used only for the provisions of emergency medical care or emergency medical services.

The Town Council hereby requests the Auditor of Snohomish County, as ex officio supervisor of elections, to submit the following proposition at such election, in the form of a ballot, titled substantially as follows:

## PROPOSITION NO. 2

GRANITE FALLS SIX (6) YEAR LEVY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

SHALL GRANITE FALLS BE AUTHORIZED TO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 25¢ PER ONE THOUSAND OF ASSESSED VALUE OF PROPERTY IN THE TAXING DISTRICT IN EACH YEAR FOR SIX (6) CONSECUTIVE YEARS, COMMENCING WITH THE YEAR 1989, FOR COLLECTION IN 1990.
