RESOLUTION NO. 91-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS ADOPTING
A CRITICAL AREAS INTERIM PROTECTIVE POLICY.

WHEREAS, RCW 36.70.050 mandates that cities planning under the Growth Management Act enact an Interim Protective Policy for "critical areas" by March 1, 1992; and

WHEREAS, RCW 36.70.050 mandates that cities planning under the Growth Management Act may be subject to penalties if they are not in compliance with RCW 36.70.050; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the legislative body of the Town of Granite Falls to at all times be in compliance with the mandates of RCW 36.70.050;

NOW, THEREFORE, the following motion is enacted as an Interim Protective Policy for the critical areas within the legally designated boundaries of the Town of Granite Falls.

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, by Council Resolution, does adopt the following "Critical Areas Interim Protective Policy".

The Town of Granite Falls shall, as an interim regulatory policy, as required by the Growth Management Acts of 1990 and 1991, protect all "critical areas" as defined in Chapter 36.70.050 by: 1. The Town's current SEPA regulations; 2. Zoning and building regulations; 3. Under the 1991 Corps of Engineers regulatory policies for Wetlands; and 4. Under the Shoreline Management Act regulations.

ADOPTED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls at a regular meeting held on the 27 day of November, 1991.
