WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls is proposing vacation of the alley lying between lots 10, 11, and 12 (on the west) and lots 7, 6, and 5 (on the east). The location of the alley is more particularly described as lying between Portage Avenue on the west, Union Street on the north, Prospect Avenue on the east, and Pioneer Street on the South; and

WHEREAS, the alley proposed for vacation is more accurately described as follows: The 13' of alley lying 45' North of Pioneer Street and extending to a point 180' South of Portage Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council declare that the alley is not necessary as a part of the general road system and the public will not be inconvenienced by its vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council that the City of Granite Falls Is proposing vacation of the 13' alley lying 45' North of Pioneer Street and extending to a point 180' South of Portage Avenue; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Granite Falls that a PUBLIC HEARING shall be held on JULY 9, 1997, at 7:30 P.M., at the Granite Falls City Hall, Council Chambers, 206 South Granite Avenue, Granite Falls, Washington, to hear all public comment concerning the proposed alley vacation.
