RESOLUTION NO. 04-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS DECLARING THE NEED FOR THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF SNOHOMISH COUNTY TO OPERATE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls has not yet activated the Housing Authority of the City of Granite Falls pursuant to Chapter 35.82 RCW; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.82.070 (3) provides that a housing authority may exercise its powers outside of its area of operation under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of Snohomish County (the "Authority") desires to acquire and operate an apartment complex known as Falls Crossing located in the City at 10110 Mountain Loop Highway and associated vacant properties (the "Project");
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 – Declaration of Need

The City declares that there is a need for the Housing Authority to exercise its powers within the boundaries of the City in connection with the acquisition and operation of this home as affordable housing, and hereby requests and authorizes the Housing Authority of Snohomish County to so exercise its powers in connection with the Project.

Section 2 Effective Date

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval.
