

RESOLUTION NO. 07-04

A RESOLUTION BY THE GRANITE FALLS CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE GRANITE FALLS ALTERNATE ROUTE RIGHT-OF-WAY PLAN PROJECT (RC1112)

WHEREAS, State Route 92, Stanley Street and Alder Avenue through downtown Granite Falls have inadequate capacity to handle existing and projected traffic; and

WHEREAS, a new alternate alignment to serve the high volume of heavy truck traffic would serve as a strategic freight corridor for the region; and

WHEREAS, an alternate alignment would improve response time and access for emergency vehicles; substantially reduce congestion, noise, and air pollution for residents and schools; and support cultural redevelopment of the City commercial core and surrounding region consistent with the Growth Management Act (GMA); and

WHEREAS, the Snohomish County Council has approved the Right-of-Way Plans of the Granite Falls Alternate Route Project (RC1112).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Granite Falls City Council hereby approves and adopts the Granite Falls Alternate Route Right-of-Way Plan Project (RC1112) for the alternate route between SR 92 and the Mountain Loop Highway; as attached hereto and incorporated by reference, as though fully set forth herein.
