## CITY OF GRANITE FALLS RESOLUTION 2011-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, DIRECTING THE DESIGNATED OFFICIAL TO PROCEED WITH ANALYSIS AND PROCESSING OF THE 2011 ANNUAL DOCKET.

WHEREAS, the Washington City of Granite Falls is a City in Snohomish County, Washington, planning under the Growth Management Act; and

WHEREAS, the City of Granite Falls has established procedures and schedules to update, amend or revise the Comprehensive Plan as required under RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a) no more frequently than once every year; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 Docket proposals include one privately proposed revision item and none proposed by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission conducted a duly noticed public meeting on the proposed list of docket items in Exhibit A on March 22, 2011, and all public testimony has been given full consideration and is included in the Planning Commission's recommendation to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, this action is exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act pursuant to WAC 197-11-800(147) and GFMC 19.07; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public meeting on the proposed 2011 Annual Docket list as provided in Exhibit A on April 6, 2011, which was duly noticed, and considered all public testimony and the Planning Commission recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Requested Action</u>. The City of Granite Falls City Council requests the Department of Planning analyze the attached list of docket items, prepare reports, and present the detailed findings to the Planning Commission and the City Council for action before the end of 2011.

Section 2. <u>2011 Docket</u>. The approved docket items, one privately proposed revision, is the official 2011 Annual Docket for the City of City of Granite Falls and will serve as the only Comprehensive Plan change considered in 2011 as allowed under RCW 36.70A.130(2)(a) and the City of City of Granite Falls Municipal Code Section 19.04.130(E) the Comprehensive Plan amendment process.

Section 3. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution should be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City of Granite Falls City Council.


