RESOLUTION 2019-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CIVIC CENTER / CITY HALL; AND APPROVING THE CHANGE ORDERS TO THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT WITH SAYBR CONTRACTORS, INC. AS INCLUDED IN EXHIBIT "A," AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE FUTURE CHANGE ORDERS RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CIVIC CENTER / CITY HALL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a Contract with Saybr Contractors Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the change orders outlined in Exhibit "A" which are revisions to the original Contract are integral to the completion of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the change orders result from unforeseen or changed conditions and design errors or omissions; and

WHEREAS, the change orders outlined in Exhibit "A" are consistent with the original bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the modifications consist of the same work in the same location as the original Contract, the Civic Center / City Hall will be substantially the same as the original project scope; and

WHEREAS, the change orders will not alter the nature of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has the authority to authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to authorizing the approval of change orders for the Civic Center/City Hall Construction Contract with Saybr Contractors, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) The City Council approves the Change Orders attached as Exhibit A and authorizes, affirms and ratifies the City Manager's approval and signature of said Change Orders.
- 2) The City Manager may approve and sign future Contract change orders subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The change order does not substantially change the scope of the project.
 - b. The total increase or decrease in the contract amount, as a result of the change order, does not exceed ten percent (10%) or \$344,987.00 of the total costs stated in the originally approved contract; provided however that no individual change order shall exceed \$25,000.
 - c. The total contract amount as adjusted by the change order is within the amount

- budgeted for the project.
- d. The approved change order is presented at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting so that the Council is informed of the actions.
- 3) If the change order is unable to meet the conditions as outlined above in 2), the City Manager shall submit the change order(s) to the City Council for approval and authority to sign.
