PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Pursuant to WAC 197-11-800(3), the city is proposing to adopt flexible categorical exemption thresholds for minor new construction at the following levels: 30 single-family residential units; 60 multifamily residential units; 40,000 sf for agricultural buildings; 30,000 sf for office/school/commercial buildings and 90 parking spaces; and 1,000 cubic yards of grading.
